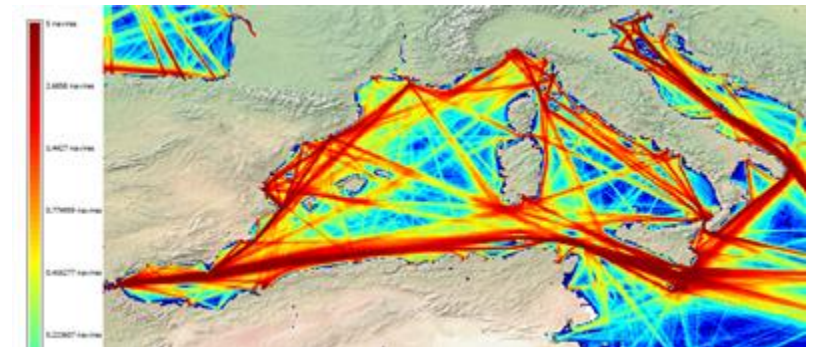

Strengthen collaboration and cooperation in the Western Mediterranean in the field of **preparedness for and response to oil and HNS pollution**



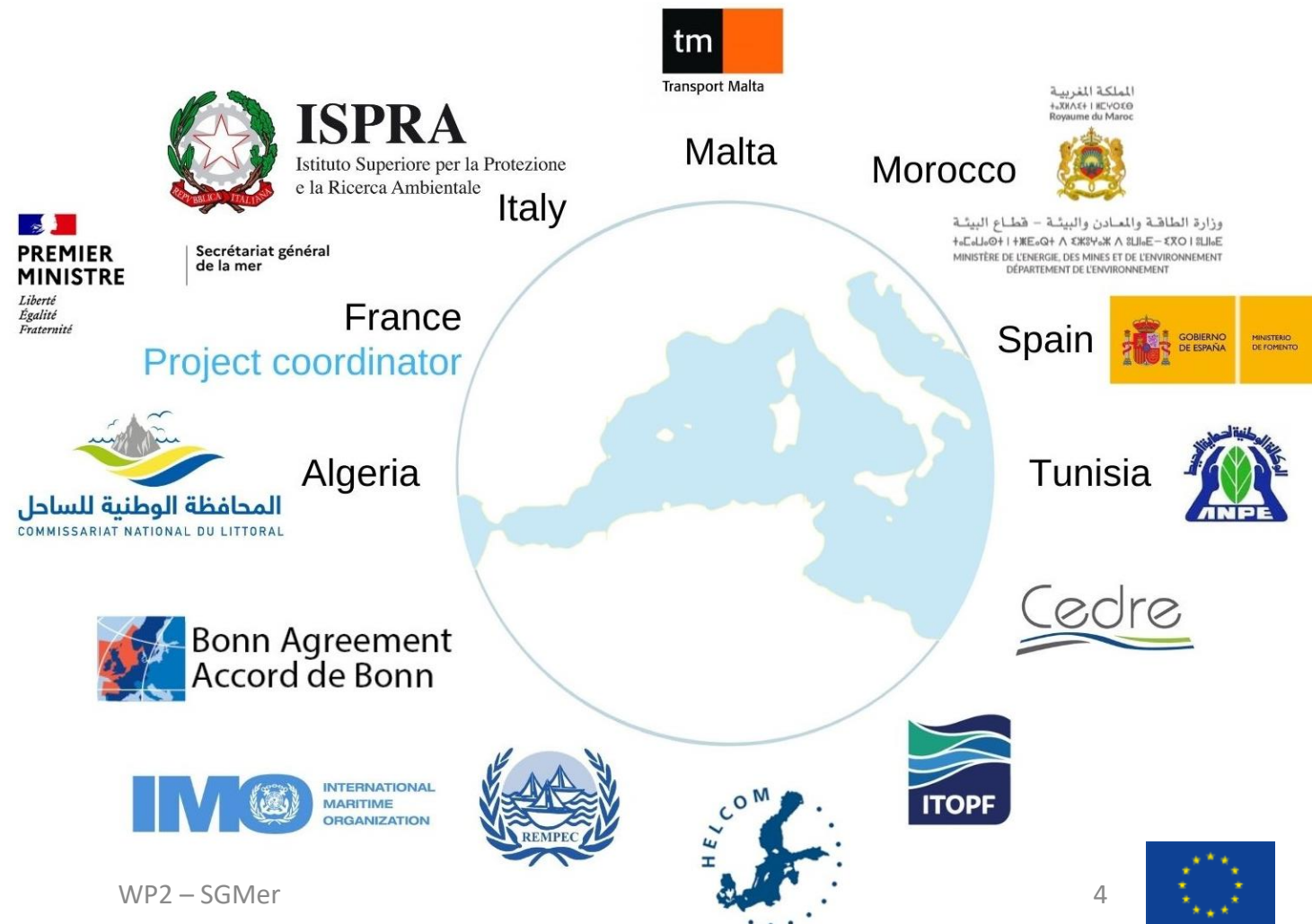

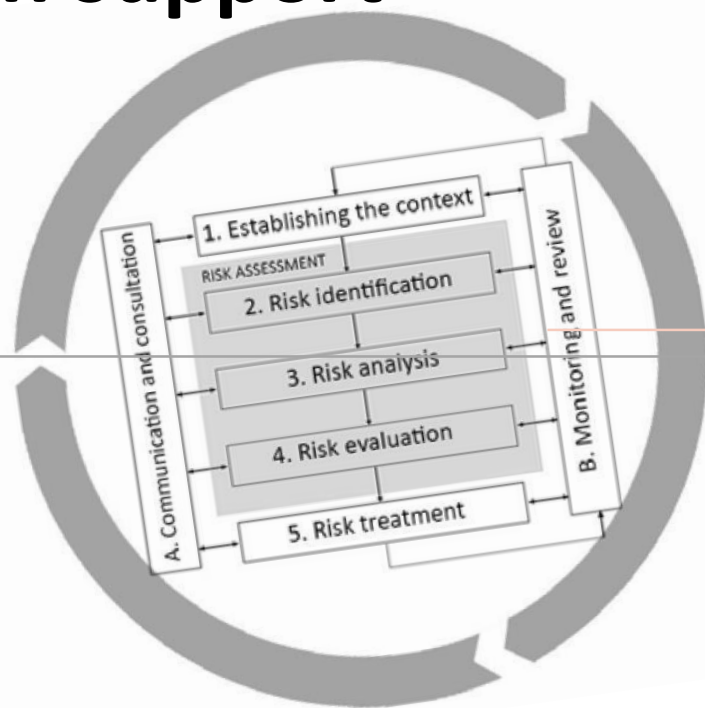
